

<b>Social Worker – Divert!</b>	
<b>Responsibilities</b>	<p>To be responsible for the delivery of a good service to children and their families who fall within the Divert! service.</p> <p>To utilise a practice model that is restorative and relational and uses systemic tools and ideas and drive the development of a team culture where social work can flourish.</p>
<p>Within Divert! are two teams with different roles:</p> <p><b>Stay! (formally the Edge of Care team)</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Supporting a team of Family Coaches in keeping families together in a safe and positive environment for the child/children.</li> <li>2. Working with specialists to deliver MST and FFT interventions, recording progress accurately with a view to ensuring any action to improve the welfare and protect the child/children/family is taken accordingly.</li> <li>3. Supporting family group conferences and promoting a whole family/whole system response to complex issues.</li> </ol> <p><b>Ten2 (formally the Complex Safeguarding team)</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. Working with children aged 10 or over where there are serious safeguarding concerns or/and risk of exploitation.</li> <li>5. Working in partnership with colleagues, specialists, and stakeholders such as schools and the police to keep children safe.</li> <li>6. Co-working with social workers from other teams, ensuring contextual risk is minimised and diverting children away from local authority care.</li> </ol>
