Service Specific Components Divert!, Care Provision and Support



Social Worker – Divert!	
Responsibilities	To be responsible for the delivery of a good service to children and their families who fall within the Divert! service.
	To utilise a practice model that is restorative and relational and uses systemic tools and ideas and drive the development of a team culture where social work can flourish.

Within Divert! are two teams with different roles:

Stay! (formally the Edge of Care team)

- 1. Supporting a team of Family Coaches in keeping families together in a safe and positive environment for the child/children.
- 2. Working with specialists to deliver MST and FFT interventions, recording progress accurately with a view to ensuring any action to improve the welfare and protect the child/children/family is taken accordingly.
- 3. Supporting family group conferences and promoting a while family/whole system response to complex issues.

Ten2 (formally the Complex Safeguarding team)

- 4. Working with children aged 10 or over where there are serious safeguarding concerns or/and risk of exploitation.
- 5. Working in partnership with colleagues, specialists, and stakeholders such as schools and the police to keep children safe.
- 6. Co-working with social workers from other teams, ensuring contextual risk is minimised and diverting children away from local authority care.
